

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

### **NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM PERMITS TO DISCHARGE TREATED WASTEWATER INTO THE WATERS OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA.**

The Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) is considering the re-issuance of NPDES permits for the following applicant, subject to specific pollutant limitations and special condition:

City of Commerce, Post Office Box 348, Commerce, Georgia 30529, for its:

NPDES Permit No. GA0032646, Davis House water pollution control plant located on Eisenhower Drive in Commerce. 0.067 MGD of treated wastewater is discharged into Grove Creek tributary to the Hudson River tributary to the Broad River in the Savannah River Basin.

NPDES Permit No. GA0032638, Holiday Inn, water pollution control plant located at the I-85 and US 441 Intersection in Commerce. 0.041 MGD of treated wastewater is discharged into Crooked Creek tributary to Grove Creek tributary to the Hudson River tributary to the Broad River in the Savannah River Basin.

The permits are being modified to contain limits for fecal coli form bacteria and 24-month compliance schedules.

Persons wishing to comment on these proposed permits are invited to submit their comments in writing to the EPD address below, within 30 days of the notice. All comments received before or on that date will be considered in the formulation of final determinations for these permits. "City of Commerce – Davis House and/or Holiday Inn Water Pollution Control Plants (Banks County)" should be placed at the top of the first page of comments. A public hearing may be held if the EPD Director finds a significant degree of public interest in these proposed permits. A public hearing may be requested, or additional information regarding public hearing procedures is available, by writing the EPD at the address noted below.

The permit applications, drafts permits, and other information are available for review at 4220 International Parkway, Suite 101, Atlanta, Georgia 30354, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday and at Commerce City Hall during normal business hours.
